Our trips cover the Old West, from Billy the Kid's Last Ride in New Mexico to Custer's Last Stand in Montana. Many of our rides are based out of the South Pass region of the Wind River Mountains in Wyoming, an historical location ideal for all levels of riding ability. Here you'll find land once traversed by mountain men and the likes of John C. Fremont and Kit Carson, and historical locales such as Oregon Buttes, Sweetwater River, the Oregon, Mormon and Pony Express Trails, and the gold rush town of South Pass City. In addition to ample riding and an adrenaline rush, these vacations offer entertainment, education and an increased appreciation for the Old West cowboy and frontier trooper.
